c-CARE II Community Health Worker (CHW) Spotlight: Ms. Percie Davis, CNA, RT Broadway Baptist Church



When Percie Davis arrived at the c-CARE II CHW training session on Saturday, June 3, 2023, at the Georgia Cancer Center, Dr. Martha Tingen, PhD, RN, FAAN, (Principal Investigator, c-CARE II) knew that this was a familiar face. Ms. Davis later revealed that she had participated in a previous community health project that Dr. Tingen had conducted in 2010-2011; the "Sister to Sister" program, a tobacco cessation research study for public housing neighborhoods in which women help other women quit smoking.

Ms. Davis had what she described as a "rough childhood": she began smoking at a very young age, and had dropped out of school in the 8th grade. When Ms. Davis joined Sister to Sister at the Barton Village housing development in 2011, she joked that "if she could quit smoking, she could do anything." With the help of the program, and Dr. Tingen's support, Ms. Davis was successful in quitting smoking. Having accomplished this seemingly impossible feat, Ms. Davis realized she really could do anything, and it changed her life. She took classes and got her GED. Next, she attended college and completed a Certified Nursing Assistant program. But she didn't stop there. With her personal experience as a former smoker, and knowing how smoking affects the respiratory system, in 2023 Ms. Davis completed training to become a Respiratory Therapist.
