GCC Flow and Mass Cytometry – Data Policy (Backup/ Storage and Recovery)

- 1. All users must backup their data off the instrument at the end of their run. This can be done during the cleaning phase.
- 2. Box is the preferred method; all users are provided a Box account via their university credentials
- 3. Data (excluding templates) stored on the instruments will be deleted on a monthly basis; i.e. for January's data this will be deleted in March.
- 4. All users are required to save their experiments into specified lab folders on C: drive.
- 5. Data will be retained for 5 years on the core designated external drive and then deleted; this will happen on a rolling monthly basis.
- 6. Users may request recovery of files which will be delivered at core staff's convenience.
- 7. The flow core highly recommends saving your experiments as Templates.
