# Wound Care & Dressing Change Order Details


**RATIONALE:** To ensure proper dressings are applied according to the written instructions to provide the high-quality care and effective resource management.

## Important Points to Remember:

- Not every foam dressing is a sacral dressing.
- Details for Wound/Care Dressing changes are written out for each order placed by wound/ostomy nursing department.
- Wound Care documentation is found in the "Clinical Notes" section of the patient's chart.



- It is **NOT** appropriate to utilize sacral foam dressings as cover dressings or securement devices for scheduled dressing changes unless specified in order details.
  - *When appropriate, orders might recommend the use of Therahoney under the sacral foam dressing.*

WOCN Wound Recommendations : Pt. admitted with reported impaired skin integrity to sacrum. Reevaluation with deep tissue injury unroofing to reveal combination dry red base and peeling darkened tissue. Small-moderate amount of creamy drainage.  
Recommend - discontinue foam dressing changes  
cleanse with wound cleanser  
apply silvadene cream  
cover with dry gauze  
secure with 2" tape  
change q 12 hr
