

Clinical Curriculum: Pediatric Resident Graduate

Clinical Curriculum Year 1 (Pediatric Graduate)

Rotations:

- 6 months Pediatric Emergency Department
- 1 month Adult Emergency Department (no PED)
- 1 month PICU (no ED)
- 1 month Adult Trauma Service (no PED)
- 1 month Pediatric Anesthesia (no PED)
- 2 months Research (8 PED)

Clinical Shifts (pediatric emergency department)

- 16 shifts/month, 9 hour shifts (75% shifts weekdays, 25% shifts weekends) all shifts done in CHOG ED
- 40 hour work week: clinical (avg 33 hours/wk); additional hours towards academic pursuits and didactics

Clinical Curriculum Year 2 (Pediatric Graduate)

Rotations:

- 5 months Pediatric Emergency Department
- 1 month Orthopedics/ sports medicine (no PED)
- 1 month Pediatric Burn Care/ Anesthesia (adult) Doctor's Hospital (4 PED)
- 1 Adult Emergency department (no PED)
- 1 month EMS-US (4 PED)
- 3 months Research (8 PED)

Clinical Shifts (pediatric emergency department)

- 15 shifts/month, 9hour shifts (75% shifts weekdays, 25% shifts weekends, all shifts done in CHOG ED)
- 40 hour work week: clinical (avg 31 hours/wk) additional hours towards academic pursuits and didactics

Clinical Curriculum Year 3 (Pediatric Graduate)

Rotations:

- 6 months Pediatric Emergency Department
- 6 months Research Months (8 PED)

Clinical Shifts (pediatric emergency department)

- 13 shifts/ month, 9 hour shifts (75% shifts weekdays, 25% shifts weekends); all shifts done in CHOG ED)
- 40 hour work week: clinical (avg 27 hours/wk) additional hours towards academic pursuits and didactics
- Reduction of one shift, months serving as a chief for 6 months out of PED months.

RRC requirements:

At least 12 months of PED (AU= 17 months)

11 months research

At least 4 months general adult medicine exposure (AU= 4.0) trauma, general ED x 2, orthopedics/sports medicine, EMS-US
