Outcomes, Results, Implications & Limitations	<i>Clearly explains results or outcome of the work, without going into detail that turns off an interdisciplinary audience. Explains why the work is important in a larger context. Able to identify limitations of the work.</i>		
Format, Visuals, & Organization	<i>Visual and oral organization (starting at the beginning and moving to the results). Proper use and clarity of figures and illustrations. Avoids masses of data or text that are difficult to quickly interpret.</i>		
Oral Delivery & Ability to Respond to Questions	<i>Ability to orally present the poster without just reading. Effective use of eye contact, body movements, enunciation, pitch, rate, and volume. Ability to answer questions and/or converse about the research/scholarship smoothly. Ability to show additional depth of knowledge with answers.</i>		
Professionalism	<i>Proper sentence structure, usage, vocabulary, and word choice. Speaks intelligently about the topic. Dress, hygiene, and overall personal presentation are professional.</i>
