Congratulations, Mr. Glidewell. Thank you for the smiles, the laughter, and for reminding us all that teamwork, friendship, and kindness never go out of style.

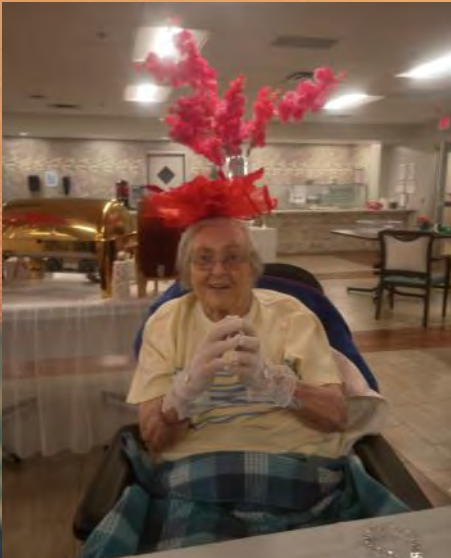
