INFECTION PREVENTION UPDATE

ATTENTION ALL VISITORS

In an effort to keep our veteran residents healthy as possible, we have implemented interim visitation requirements for all visitors to Georgia War.

Respiratory illnesses are widespread in Georgia at this time and we are in peak Flu season. The single best way to protect against all respiratory illnesses is to utilize preventative measures such as handwashing, wiping surfaces, and covering your cough. The Georgia War staff are implementing many of the recommendations from the Department of Human Health (DPH) to maintain and ensure your loved one remains as healthy as possible. We recognize our geriatric residents at Georgia War are at high risk for all respiratory illnesses even with vaccination.

Effective immediately and until further notice, additional precautionary measures are as follows:

All visitors for residents at Georgia War Veterans Nursing Home:

- 1) No visits by anyone under the age of 18
- 2) To protect everyone's health, anyone with symptoms of **fever, cough, sore throat, runny nose, stuffy nose, fatigue, drowsiness, headaches, body aches, nausea or vomiting**, please avoid visiting the facility until these have resolved **(at least 72 hours)**.

Please communicate this information to your family and friends who may be affected by these additional interim precautions. Once we are notified that the respiratory rates in the community have decreased we will cancel the restrictions.


**From the time I was conceived God had for me a plan


