

THE CHAPLAIN'S CORNER

WITH CHAPLAIN TIMOTHY LARK

A Fresh (24)

Hello June! How did you get here so quickly?

Greetings to everyone who has returned to our monthly newsletter. The Lord has granted us another day. In the words of a wonderful pastor friend, "a Fresh (24)". The more I think about that, the more excited I become, since it's a new day bursting with new opportunities and possibilities!

There is nothing we can do about yesterday, and tomorrow might not arrive for any of us, so please take care of today. Today, what will you do differently? God has given each of us another chance to try something different. If you keep doing the same old things, you'll probably keep getting the same old results. Change can be difficult for all of us for many reasons, including our natural human inclination to stick to routine and familiarity. God wants us to grow and change to become more like Him. Scripture emphasizes both the possibility and the inevitability of change, especially concerning spiritual growth and transformation. It illuminates the concept of transforming one's "old self" into a "new self" via faith and divine favor. Scriptures exhort believers to "be transformed by the renewing of your mind" (Romans 12:2) and to "put off the old self and put on the new self' (Ephesians 4:20-25).

As we continue to learn, grow, and finish developing, let me conclude with a brief but impactful prayer that promotes acceptance of what cannot be changed, bravery to change what can be, and the discernment to realize the difference. It's called the Serenity Prayer by Reinhold Niebuhr. I believe that if you apply this prayer to your life, it will help your overall well-being.

"God, grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change, the courage to change the things I can, and the wisdom to know the difference."






