 3. Possesses a reputation as a master teacher.
 4. Teaches by example as well as by didactic methods.
 5. Is an exemplary mentor and provides effective professional and academic advisement to students.
 6. Integrates current research findings and issues in presentations.
 7. Number of students for who he/she has served as either the major advisor or on their advisory committee.
