Congratulations on your upcoming graduation! We are excited to announce that we will be offering three in-person ceremonies on May 8-9 at the Augusta Convention Center.

Thursday, May 8th, 6 pm: Graduate Hooding & Commencement Ceremony
Celebrating all students in The Graduate School.

Friday, May 9th, 10 am: Undergraduate Commencement Ceremony 1
Celebrating undergraduate students from College of Allied Health Sciences, College of Education & Human Development, Hull College of Business, Pamplin College of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences

Friday, May 9th, 2 pm: Undergraduate Commencement Ceremony 2
Celebrating undergraduate students from College of Nursing, College of Science and Math, and School of Computer and Cyber Sciences

As a part of the ceremony, each student will walk across the stage and be recognized. Immediately upon arrival, students will be checked in and directed to their seats on the floor.

There will be NO rehearsal for all graduating students. Directions will be given from the podium during the ceremony.

Ushers will direct students to and from the podium during the ceremony as well. Please be attentive!

Academic Regalia

Regalia is available to order through April 1 at jostens.com. Official Augusta University regalia is used by all participants in the commencement ceremony. Any regalia orders placed after April 1 will be taken in-person at the RoarStore. Hood and/or tassel colors are not guaranteed with any late orders placed after the online order deadline. After ordering your regalia, should you not be able to participate, please notify the RoarStore at bookstore@augusta.edu

For Associates, Bachelors, Masters, and Specialists graduates:

Regalia orders may be placed online via the Jostens website through April 1. The regalia package for associates and bachelors graduates is \$49. The masters and specialists regalia package is \$99. Any orders placed after April 1 will be taken in-person at the RoarStore on the Summerville Campus. Hood and/or tassel colors are not guaranteed for any orders placed after the order deadline. All Associates, Bachelors, Masters and Specialists graduates will keep their regalia at the conclusion of the event.

For Doctoral graduates:

Doctoral regalia packages are rental only and only available online at jostens.com. Students must place their order by March 16. Regalia rentals will be available for pick-up at the Summerville Campus RoarStore beginning April 25 during operating hours. Graduates must return their regalia after the ceremony. Returns can be made immediately following the ceremony or at the Summerville Campus RoarStore during operating hours. All doctoral regalia must be returned by May 16. A \$30 late fee will be assessed to any late returns.

Undergraduate Latin Honors

Undergraduate students graduating with honors will be recognized during the commencement ceremony and designated in the commencement program. Your GPA from the previous term will indicate if you will participate in commencement with honors. Qualifying students will be notified via email and may pick up the cords from the Registrar's Office **beginning March 3**.

Legacy Graduates

Generations of families have continued Augusta University's rich tradition, continuing our legacy like no other in JagNation. You may qualify as a legacy graduate if your parent, stepparent, or grandparent attended Augusta University or one of our legacy institutions, such as Augusta College. Legacy status is only awarded to those family members who have received a degree from Augusta University or a legacy institution, not to those completing residency.

If you believe you qualify to be included in our legacy graduates for this semester, and did NOT indicate so on your graduation application, please email your family member's name and when/where they graduated from to commencement@augusta.edu by no later than **Friday, March 14**.



Tassel

Tassel, formerly known as Marching Order, is the system used to manage commencement operations, including graduate RSVP's, guest ticketing, graduate communications, and stage passes. Graduates **MUST** create an account in Tassel to RSVP for the ceremony, access their guest tickets, and ensure their name is pronounced and listed correctly for the commencement ceremony.

Students will need to create a Tassel account with their Augusta University email. Tassel will open on February 14 and close on April 12. **Do NOT attempt to login to Tassel until it opens for all graduates**. All students are required to RSVP during this registration period for important information about the commencement ceremony, the awarding of your degree, and diploma delivery. Registration information will be sent to graduates on February 14. Be sure to check your junk/spam folders for any communication sent via Tassel after it has opened.

Parking

The convention center's address is 2 10th Street, Augusta, Georgia. Commencement guests are encouraged to park in the Reynolds Street parking deck.

Commencement participants: You will park at the Georgia Cyber Center's parking deck (100 Grace Hopper Lane, Augusta). A parking attendant will be present to let you in the deck at no charge. If you decide to carpool with family to commencement, this will not impact your ability to park at this deck. Walk over to the convention center from this deck to check-in for commencement.

Stage Passes and Name Cards

Graduates will need to access their Stage Pass, your ticket into commencement, through their Tassel (formerly Marching Order) account. This is a necessity for you to check in to commencement.

Directions of how to access your Stage Pass are included in your Tassel account.

Name cards will be printed for graduates to use during commencement. Name cards are what students will need to cross the stage to have their name announced and to receive their diploma.

Guest Tickets

Tickets will be required for all guests attending our commencement ceremonies, including children and infants over the age of one. The number of tickets each graduate will receive will be decided upon at a later date. Students will be able to access and send tickets directly to their guests through their Tassel (formerly Marching Order) account.

All ticket information will be announced through Augusta University email for all graduates. Students will be required to use their AU email address and student ID number to log in to the portal once ticketing becomes available. If we are able to release additional tickets to students once the initial round of tickets is claimed, we will notify graduates via email and/or text message about steps to claim additional tickets. Graduates, please ensure the phone number provided on your graduation application is an active phone number able to receive texts.

Guest seating is general admission for all ceremonies. The doors will open approximately 90 minutes prior to the start of both ceremonies.



Graduate Exit Survey

The Graduation Exit Survey will open later this semester for all spring 2025 graduates. Graduates are expected to complete this survey to share your post-graduation plans with the university. Graduates will receive notice of the survey opening via their Augusta University email account or the post-graduation email provided on your graduation application.
