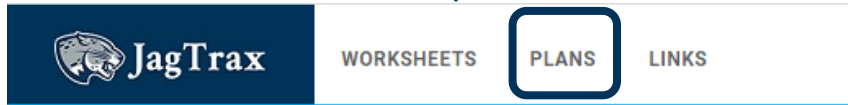
## INTRODUCTION

2. The Plan List will display a list of all plans available for your record. If you do not have any plans, contact your academic advisor.



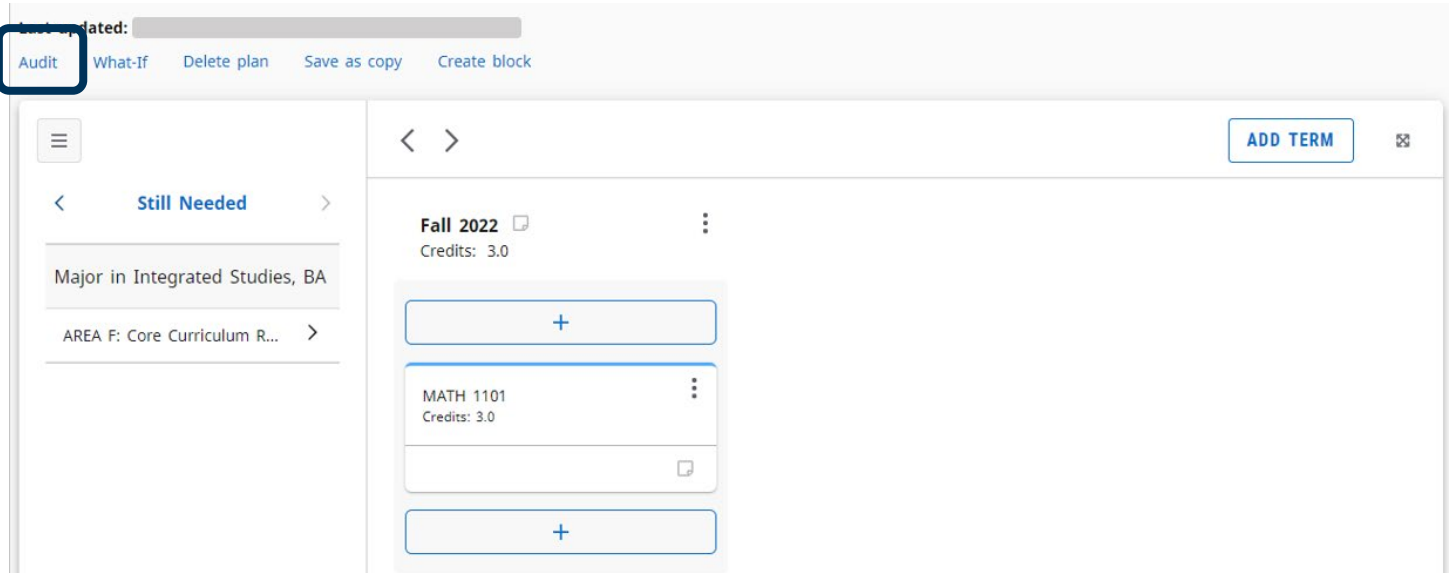
