## **Technical Standards Attestation Tracking**

The Medical College of Georgia maintains Technical Standard for Admission, Matriculation, Continuation, and Graduation. All students acknowledge receipt of these standards by completing an attestation statement sent to them by the Office of Admissions at the time of acceptance.
