Required Competencies

Required Competency 1

- Patient Care and Procedural Skills
 - Health Care Professionals must be able to provide patient care that is compassionate, appropriate, and effective for the treatment of health problems and the promotion of health.
 - Students must complete a <u>minimum</u> of 100 shadowing/volunteering hours for MCG and 75 clinical hours and 75 non-profit volunteer hours for DCG.

Required Competency 2

- Basic Science Knowledge
 - Health Care Professionals must demonstrate knowledge of established and evolving biomedical, clinical, epidemiological, and social-behavioral sciences
 - Students must meet minimum yearly academic requirements (minimum GPA).

Required Competency 3

- Practice-based Learning and Improvement
 - Health Care Professionals must demonstrate the ability to investigate and evaluate, appraise, and assimilate scientific evidence, and to continuously improve future patient care based on constant self-evaluation and life-long learning.
 - Students must develop skills and habits commensurate to meet the following:
 - Identify strengths, deficiencies, and limits in one's knowledge and expertise.
 - Incorporate formative evaluation feedback into daily practice and set improvement goals.
 - Use information technology to optimize learning.
 - Participate in the education of others including students, patients, families, and health professionals when applicable.

Required Competency 4

- Interpersonal and Communication Skills
 - Health Care Professionals must demonstrate interpersonal and communication skills that result in the effective exchange of information and collaboration with others.
 - Students must:
 - Communicate effectively with colleagues, faculty, the public, patients and families, as appropriate across a broad range of socioeconomic and cultural backgrounds.
 - Work effectively as a member or leader of a team or other preprofessional group.
 - Maintain comprehensive, timely, and legible assignments and communications.

Required Competency 5

- Professionalism
 - Health Care Professionals must demonstrate a commitment to carrying out professional responsibilities and an adherence to ethical principles.
 - Students must demonstrate:
 - Compassion, integrity, and respect for others
 - Responsiveness to others needs that supersedes self-interest
 - Respect for patient privacy and autonomy
 - Accountability to colleagues, faculty, and society which aligns with a future profession in medicine/dentistry
 - Sensitivity and responsiveness to a diverse patient population, including but not limited to diversity in gender, age, culture, race, religion, disabilities, and sexual orientation
