Requirements for Service Animals in Training

Documentation must be provided that the animal in training is working with an accredited agency and the animal who is training must be clearly marked as such.

Service animals and service animals in training must:

- 1. Be under the control of the handler at all times.
- 2. Be in compliance with laws pertaining to animal licensing, vaccination and owner identification.

Service animals and service animals in training may be excluded from campus if any of the following occur:

- 1. The animal is out of control and effective actions is not taken to control it.
- 2. The animal is not housebroken
- 3. The animal poses a direct threat to the health or safety of others.

The handler/owner of the service animal will be responsible for any damages or injuries incurred by the service animal or service animal in training.
